May 22, 2019

The City Council met in special session in the Municipal Building—202 West Elm Street. Present on Roll Call were Mayor Amiel Redfish and Council Members: Curt Lundquist, Terry Rowbotham, Garth Johnson, Jesse Steffensen, Rob Achterberg and Cory Falconer. Absent: None.

The purpose of the meeting was to review building permit applications and have an executive session for possible litigation, contract matter and personnel matter.

John Farstad submitted a building permit application for a privacy fence in his back yard at Lot 3, Block 7, of Lot C Johnson Addition—101 W Hickory Street. Motion was made by Achterberg, seconded by Lundquist to approve this permit. All in favor—Carried.

Kevin Young presented a building permit application to install a privacy fence at Lot 2, Block 10, Auditors Plat in S½ NW 1-110-53—404 S 3rd Street. Motion was made by Rowbotham, seconded by Falconer to approve this permit. All in favor—Carried.
