October 16, 2020

The City Council met in the Municipal Building—202 West Elm Street. Present on Roll Call were Mayor Curt Lundquist and Council Members: Terry Mutziger, Terry Rowbotham, Garth Johnson, Jesse Steffensen and Rob Achterberg. Absent: Cory Falconer.

The purpose of the special meeting was to meet with Scott Mohror and Beth Niemeyer, Banner Associates, to discuss the plans for the South 3rd Street Project. Earlier the council had instructed Beth to come back to the council with the pricing for 4 different options to the plan. Scott advised that was not advisable due to the expense of designing would be very costly. The engineering contract will need to be revised to include the extra services for this project.

After many questions and discussion, the Motion was made by Rowbotham, seconded by Steffensen to leave the driving service at 25 ft—extend the asphalt surface going west to 453rd Street—take the water down to that intersection and install a fire hydrant for flushing. No lift station will be installed at this time. The plan is to install rollback curb on the project, however; curb and gutter hearings will need to be held for the area where there is no current curb and that would be assessed to the property owners. The project would then be bid in March 2021. All in favor—Carried.

Motion to adjourn was made by Achterberg, seconded by Mutzinger. All in favor—Carried.
